



Psalm 8:4-5, 6-7, 8-9, R. 2ab






- 1/. When I see the heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars which you arranged, what is man that you should keep him in mind, the son of man that you care for him?
- 2/. Yet you have made him little lower <u>than</u> the angels; with glory and ho<u>nour</u> you crowned him, gave him power over the works <u>of</u> your hands: you put all things un<u>der</u> his feet.
- 3/. All of them, sheep and oxen, yes, even the cattle of the fields, birds of the air, and fish of the sea that make their way through the waters.

- 3/. With you is <u>prince</u>ly rule on the day <u>of</u> your power.


 In holy splendour, from the womb before the dawn, I have begotten you.

- 1/. The LORD is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want. Fresh and green are the pastures where he gives me repose. Near restful waters he leads me; he revives my soul.
- 2/. He guides me along the <u>right</u> path, for the sake <u>of</u> his name.
 Though I should walk in the valley of the shadow <u>of</u> death, no evil would I fear, for <u>you</u> are with me.
 Your crook and your staff will <u>give</u> me comfort.
- 3/. You have prepared a table <u>before</u> me in the sight <u>of</u> my foes.My head you have anointed <u>with</u> oil;

my cup is overflowing.

4/. Surely goodness and mercy shall <u>follow</u> me all the days <u>of</u> my life.
In the LORD's own house shall <u>I</u> dwell for length of <u>days</u> unending.
