

First Sunday in Advent Year C To you, O LORD, I lift up my soul


Lectionary No. 3 Psalm 25(24):4-5b. 8-9. 10, 14. R. 1b



- 1/. O LORD, make me know your ways.Teach me your paths.Guide me in your truth, and teach me; for you are the God of my salvation.
- 2/. Good and upright <u>is</u> the LORD; therefore he shows the <u>way</u> to sinners. He guides the humble <u>in</u> right judgement; to the humble he teach<u>es</u> his way.
- 3/. All the LORD's paths are mercy and faithfulness, for those who keep his covenant and commands. The LORD's secret is for those who fear him; to them he reveals his covenant.

Second Sunday in Advent Year C What great deeds the LORD worked for us! Indeed, we were glad.


Lectionary No. 6 Psalm 126(125): 1-2b. 2c-3. 4-5. 6. R.3



- 1/. When the LORD brought back the exiles of Sion, we <u>thought</u> we were dreaming.
 Then was our mouth <u>filled</u> with laughter; on our tongues, <u>songs</u> of joy.
- 2/. Then they said am<u>ong</u> the nations,'What great deeds the <u>LORD</u> worked for them!'What great deeds the LORD <u>worked</u> for us!Indeed, <u>we</u> were glad.
- 3/. Bring back our exiles, O LORD, as <u>streams</u> in the Negeb. Those who are sowing in tears will sing <u>when</u> they reap.
- 4/. They go out, they go out, <u>full</u> of tears, bearing <u>seed</u> for the sowing; they come back, they come back with a song, bear<u>ing</u> their sheaves.

Third Sunday in Advent Year C Shout aloud and sing praise, for great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel.

Lectionary No. 9 Isaiah 12:2-3. 4b-d. 5-6. R.6



- 1/. Behold, God <u>is</u> my salvation!
 I will trust, and will <u>not</u> be afraid, for the LORD is my <u>strength</u> and my praise, and he has been <u>my</u> salvation.
 With joy you <u>will</u> draw water from the springs <u>of</u> salvation.
- 2/. Give thanks to the LORD, <u>in</u>voke his name; make known among the peo<u>ples</u> his deeds; proclaim that his name <u>is</u> exalted.
- 3/. Sing to the LORD for <u>he</u> has wrought wonders; let this be known through <u>all</u> the earth. Shout aloud and sing praise, you who <u>dwell</u> in Sion, for great in your midst is the Holy <u>One</u> of Israel.

Fourth Sunday in Advent Year C

Bring us back, O God; let your face shine forth, and we shall be saved.

> *Lectionary No. 12* Psalm 80(79):2ac, 3b, 15-16. 18-19. R. 4



- 1/. O shepherd of Isra<u>el</u>, hear us, enthroned on the cherubim, shine forth. Rouse up your might and come to save us.
- 2/. God of hosts, turn again, we <u>implore</u>; look down from heaven <u>and</u> see.
 Visit this vine and <u>protect</u> it, the stock your right hand <u>has</u> planted, the son you have claimed for yourself.
- 3/. May your hand be on the man at your right hand, the son of man you have confirmed as your own. And we shall never forsake you <u>again</u>; give us life that we may call upon <u>your</u> name.
