
- 1/. Blessed are you, O Lord, the God of our ancestors.

- 6/. Blessed are you in the firmament of heaven.



- 1/. O Jerusalem, glorify the LORD! O Sion, praise your God!
 - He has strengthened the bars of your gates; he has blessed your children within you.
- 2/. He established peace on your borders; he gives you your fill of finest wheat. He sends out his word to the earth, and swiftly runs his command.
- 3/. He reveals his word to Jacob; to Israel, his decrees and judgements. He has not dealt thus with other nations; he has not taught them his judgements.

- 1/. Bless the LORD, <u>O</u> my soul, and all within me, <u>his</u> holy name. Bless the LORD, <u>O</u> my soul, and never forget <u>all</u> his benefits.
- 2/. It is the Lord who forgives <u>all</u> your sins, who heals every <u>one</u> of your ills, who redeems your <u>life</u> from the grave, who crowns you with mercy <u>and</u> compassion.
- 3/. The LORD does <u>deeds</u> of justice, gives full justice to all <u>who</u> are oppressed. He made known his <u>ways</u> to Moses, and his deeds to the child<u>ren</u> of Israel.
- 4/. The LORD is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and rich in mercy.
 He does not treat us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our faults.
